



Environmental Policy Statement

PLP Construction Limited is aware of the importance of environmental issues both within the construction sector and the wider community as a whole. We are committed to comply with all relevant environmental legislation and to aim to continually improve environmental performance through appropriate initiatives, controls, provision of resources and training of employees. PLP Construction Limited seeks to benefit the local environment whilst minimising the negative environmental consequences of our activities.

Our environmental management objectives and targets are reviewed on a regular basis and are based on a commitment to the following environmental principles:

- **Reducing our carbon footprint and improving our energy efficiency** – this is focussed on our most significant contributions which are transport and site fuel use. We will identify ways to improve these including the reduction of our mileage, increasing fleet efficiency and improving driver behaviour. To tackle fuel use on site we are directing our efforts at plant specification, project design, planning and operational set up.
- **The use of sustainable materials** – the materials we use on our construction projects contribute to our environmental performance and as such we recognise the contribution sustainable materials make to improved environmental performance. We are identifying ways to increase the amount of recycled materials we use, particularly aggregates and excavation reinstatements. We will continue to support initiatives to minimise waste materials and increase the amount that we divert from landfill, thereby improving resource efficiency. We are also committed to improving the way we procure our core materials such as concrete and steel, as well as others such as timber, to ensure they are sourced through responsible organisations that have established processes to validate the materials have demonstrable environmental credentials.
- We will take whatever measures may be necessary to ensure that the collection, transport and disposal facilities which we utilise are not and do not become hazardous to public health or the environment.
- Maintaining a high awareness of environmental issues in the workforce through continuous training and the promotion of the reuse and recycling of products on our sites.
- Gaining respect from the local communities by ensuring our sites are clean and tidy, and that dust and noise are kept to a minimum.
- Involving suppliers, subcontractors and clients in meeting our environmental objectives, introducing environmental initiatives and ensuring we always follow Best Practice.

The Management are committed to work to continually monitor and improve our environmental performance through the setting of clear objectives and targets.

The Environmental Policy is communicated to all employees and we promote environmental awareness throughout the company to ensure working practices are carried out in accordance with this policy. This policy is also made available to the public on request.
