



Environmental Policy Statement

PLP Construction Limited is committed to the protection and enhancement of the environment. As part of our commercial activities and operations our goal is to minimise the negative impact of our operations.

Our environmental management objectives and targets are continually reviewed through clear objectives, targets and programmes; we are ISO 14001:2015 accredited (ISOQAR Certification Nr 8836) and our objectives and targets are based on a commitment to the following environmental principles:

- We are committed to comply with all relevant environmental legislation and aim to continually improve environmental performance through appropriate initiatives, controls, provision of resources and training of employees.
- **Reducing our carbon footprint and improving our energy efficiency** – this is focussed on our most significant contributions which are transport and site fuel use. We will identify ways to improve these including the reduction of our mileage, increasing fleet efficiency and improving driver behaviour. To tackle fuel use on site we are directing our efforts at plant specification, project design, planning and operational set up.
- **Sourcing responsibly** – the materials we use on our construction projects contribute to our environmental performance and as such we recognise the contribution sustainable materials make to improved environmental performance. Our responsible sourcing commitment mandates the selection of products with the lowest environmental impact. This includes the use of non-hazardous and/or reusable materials, wherever practical. We also require our timber suppliers to provide 100% FSC or PEFC accredited materials.
- Where waste arises on our projects we operate strict management protocols. Last year we diverted 95% of waste from landfill. We will continue to support initiatives to minimise waste materials and increase the amount that we divert from landfill.
- Reducing our water consumption and improving water efficiency
- Minimising polluting emissions or discharges to the environment
- Proactively protecting, preserving and enhancing wildlife/flora and their natural habitats
- Environmental Risk Assessments are carried out on all our sites and office to formulate plans that will help us to reduce the impact of noise, dust and waste.
- Gaining respect from the local communities by ensuring our sites are clean and tidy, and that dust and noise are kept to a minimum.
- Enhancing employee understanding of environmental sustainability through environmental training and clear direction
- Engaging our supply chain in improving their environmental performance and responsible sourcing

The Senior Management Team provide visible leadership in environmental matters and are committed to work to continually monitor and improve the environmental performance of PLP Construction Limited, objectives and targets are set at the management review.

The participation and co-operation of all employees and supply chain is vital to the success of this policy. Our Environmental Policy Statement is communicated throughout PLP Construction Limited and our supply chain and is available to interested parties on request.
